

Ministry Fair: Beginning this fall TRUCC will be hosting "pop-up" ministry fairs. These impromptu fairs are one way that we can directly offer our surrounding community a glimpse of the many great things that TRUCC has to offer: radical hospitality, creative worship, thoughtful reflection of scripture, and a Spirit-filled desire for God's justice! Volunteers are needed to accompany Pastor Don to community events with about a week's notice to invite curious seekers to be part of "the next big thing" in the local church scene!

NAACP Community Discussion - On Thursday, September 1st at 6:00 pm TRUCC will host the next session of an ongoing community conversation that began after recent violence against city police in Columbia and Lancaster. The Lancaster NAACP will facilitate this conversation between local community members, police officers, civic leaders, clergy, and community members. If you've been concerned about the problems of violence that have divided so many communities across the country, and felt helpless to imagine a constructive response, this gathering will provide an opportunity to make a real difference in yourself and in national conversations.

Challenging Faith - TRUCC's weekly Bible discussion group will resume this September 4th from 1:00pm-2:30pm. Throughout the month of September we will embark on a *HOLY ADVENTURE* as we explore the Bible's stories about spiritual risk-taking and co-creating with God.

Then, beginning in October, we will begin lively and thoughtful conversations about Hebrew prophecy in the Old Testament, and the ways that we can use ancient wisdom to offer hope in an anxious world.

In case you haven't heard, the UCC's General Synod meeting for June 2017 is going to be held in nearby Baltimore, MD! This presents a unique opportunity to see how the UCC works and worships when members from across the whole USA (and some other places, too) gather for this celebration of all things UCC. In preparation for this event, we will be dedicating occasional sessions of Challenging Faith to discussions of UCC history, ecclesiology (the way we "do church"), and polity (the way things are run in the denomination). I will announce these sessions in advance as planning develops throughout the coming year. Some of our regular participants have said that this is, "the best Bible study that Trinity has ever had."

Come check out what the buzz is all about. Expect to see scripture in a whole new way!
